At Mullauna Secondary College we believe we need to prepare our students for their future, by facilitating their discovery through critical thinking, higher order thinking, collaboration, creativity and communication through a rich blend of traditional and digital learning environments.

Our '*anywhere, anytime*' philosophy is outlined in the following BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) program and is supported by excellent IT facilities to ensure that students can confidently navigate our ever-changing digital world.

Mullauna has implemented a 'preferred device' policy and have partnered with Learning with Technologies (LWT) to provide preferred devices for students at our school.

LWT have set up a dedicated [online ordering platform](#) specifically for Mullauna College.

- LWT offer devices which are commercial grade with a 3-year on-site (school) warranty.
- LWT offers optional 3-year insurance for accidental damage protection.
- LWT have access to special educational pricing.
- LWT will be setup with a pre-build Windows operating system that includes all the relevant applications the students will need.
- LWT provides onsite support at the school for warranty and insurance claims.
- LWT offers a \$100 deposit option to secure a device alternatively, there is a 36-month finance option.

Students will be able to access the school internet (eduSTAR) and the school Toshiba copier to print.

Students will also be given an email address that will give them access to the Microsoft Office 365 environment. Microsoft Office 365, via the Department of Education, offers:

- Outlook online or desktop application. All email addresses use @schools.vic.edu.au
- Collaboration platform (MS Teams, MS OneNote)
- Offline Office 365 applications for Windows or Mac OS installs on up to 5 devices (Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Microsoft Defender)
- Online storage via OneDrive (5Tb)

Office 365 is not for student records. No student address information, health, medical, behavioral or welfare information will be stored in Office 365.

NOTE: All students will be required to read and agree to the school Acceptable Use of IT Agreement as part of the enrolment process.
